S.J.VAZIFDAR, ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE (ORAL):

The only relief that the petitioner claims is that a direction be issued to the District Magistrate to dispose of the application filed under Section 14 of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest, Act, 2002 (for short 'SARFAESI Act').

There is no reason to believe that the District Magistrate will not dispose of the matter in its turn. There is also no reason to believe that the District Magistrate will unnecessarily adjourn the matter on the next date fixed i.e.10.05.2016. We would only request the District Magistrate to list the matter and hear the same in its turn without adjourning it unless required.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
