Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the action of respondents restraining the petitioners from running the agency with respect to Centre/State Lotteries as per the provisions of the Lotteries (Regulation) Act, 1998, Lotteries (Regulations) Rules, 2010 and Punjab State Lotteries Rules and further directing the respondents to videograph the entire raid/inspection and not to unnecessarily harass the petitioners.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that

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the petitioners moved representation dated 30.04.2015 (Annexure P-14) to respondent Nos.1 to 4, but the same has not been decided till today. He restricts his prayer that direction may be issued to respondent No.4 to decide the representation dated 30.04.2015 (Annexure P-14).

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, to look into the grievance of the petitioners, as mentioned in representation dated 30.04.2015 (Annexure P-14), in accordance with law, at the earliest, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and copy of the order so passed shall be communicated forthwith to the petitioners.
