The petitioner filed revision before the Financial Commissioner against ex parte proceedings in a partition case along with an application for staying the operation of Sanad Taqsim and for maintaining status quo qua possession.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends, longer date i.e. 12.07.2016 has been given without giving preliminary hearing to the revision petition filed before Financial Commissioner. Learned counsel further states that taking advantage of the non-hearing of the revision for a long period, the respondents are taking steps to take possession of the land of the petitioner.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner and in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is disposed of, without notice to the respondents, with the direction to the Financial Commissioner to prepone the date in revision and take up the case for preliminary hearing on 10.05.2016 or 17.05.2016 and take a decision whether it is a case of issuance of notice to the opposite party before 20.05.2016, positively.
