Application is allowed. Annexures P-12 and P-13 are taken on record.

CWP No. 8884 of 2016

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the writ petitions filed by other similarly situated employees have been disposed of with a direction to consider their case. The order passed in CWP No. 21117 of 2016 is reproduced as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that similarly situated employees filed ***CWP No.17640 of 2015*** and the same was disposed of in terms of

order passed in *CWP No.12023 of 2015*.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, in case, the same directions are issued in this case also.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.7 to 16 to consider the case of the petitioners in terms of order passed in *CWP No.12023 of 2015* within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the petitioners are found to be entitled for the relief sought for in the representation, which is annexed as Annexure P-7 with the petition, the same be granted to them within a period of two months thereafter.

However, in case, the petitioners are still aggrieved in any manner, they are at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case the directions are issued to the respondents to consider their case at par with similarly situated employees.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners in terms of order passed in *CWP No.12023 of 2015* within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the petitioners are found to be entitled for the relief sought for in the legal notice, which is annexed as Annexure P-7 with

the petition, the same be granted to them within a period of two months thereafter.

However, in case, the petitioners are still aggrieved in any manner, they are at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy.
