The petitioner was allotted a shop/booth in the New Vegetable Market, Madlauda on the terms and conditions contained in an allotment letter dated 28.05.2015. The petitioner accepted the allotment without protest or demur. Five months later, by a letter dated 15.10.2015 (Annexure P-6), the petitioner contended that the reserve price ought to have been ₹ 6,40,000/- and not ₹ 12,20,000/-. There has been no response to this letter.

2. The petition is, therefore, disposed of by directing the respondents to reply to the petitioner's letter dated 15.10.2015 (Annexure P-6) within four weeks from today.

3. It is clarified that if the petitioner does not make payment of the installments as per the letter of allotment, it does so at its own risk. This order ought not to be construed as a stay of the payment of installments.
