RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK J. (ORAL)

Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court, by way of instant writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that when the genuine grievance of the petitioners was not being redressed by the respondent authorities, he finally approached respondent No.2 by way of complaint dated 20.04.2016 (Annexure P-10), but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that the petitioners will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 – Deputy Commissioner, Palwal is directed to consider and decide his complaint, within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without

limitation, if any, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, the Deputy Commissioner Palwal - respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioners, raised vide his complaint dated 20.04.2016 (Annexure P10) and decide the same ensuring that an appropriate enquiry is conducted by the Enquiry Officer i.e SDO(C) Hodal – respondent no.3 against respondent no.5 keeping in view the communication dated 25.02.2016 (Annexure P9), at an early date by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
