Petitioner seeks consideration of appointment to the post of Hindi Mistress, advertised in the year 1994, on the strength of a representation/legal notice dated 22.08.2015 (Annexure P13). Earlier also, the petitioner had approached this Court in CWP-26413-2014, which was dismissed as withdrawn on 21.07.2015 (Annexure P12), with liberty to approach the authorities.

A period of more than 2 decades have gone by and various selections have taken place in between. The last process was initiated in December, 2015. The process of selection cannot go on forever and curtains have to come down and thus, curtains have to come down on this misconceived petition. No such direction can be sought for deciding the claim, at this belated stage. Accordingly, this Court is not inclined to exercise its extraordinary jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

Dismissed in limine.
