Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No. 1- Financial Commissioner, Revenue, Haryana to hear and decide the revision petition filed by the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that revision petition is pending before respondent No. 1- Financial Commissioner, Revenue, Haryana since 2012 but no decision has been taken till date.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to

respondent No.1-Financial Commissioner, Revenue, Haryana to take a decision on the revision petition dated 16.02.2012 (Annexure P-6), in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The petitioners will be at liberty to press for stay, if any application for injunction has been filed along with the revision.
