Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly concedes that in view of dismissal of the declaratory petition filed under Section 11 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 for acceptance of his title qua the suit-land, the resistance against implementation of the eviction order will not sustain. He thus seeks to withdraw this writ petition.

Ordered accordingly.

However, a copy of the order passed by the Appellate Authority under Section 11 of the 1961 Act be made available to the petitioner within two weeks to enable him to

have recourse to the remedy as may be available in law and till
then execution of warrants of possession be kept in abeyance.
