Instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to get the conveyance deed executed in favour of the petitioners and to handover possession of the allotted property.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have purchased the property in open auction but inspite of deposit of the consideration amount sale deed has not been executed so far. He further contends that despite writing number of letters no action has been taken. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that direction may be issued to decide the representation dated 19.03.2015 (Annexure P-5) and 30.09.2015 (Annexure P-6), respectively.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of, without issuing notice to the

respondent, with a direction to respondent- Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Patiala to take a decision on representation dated 19.03.2015 (Annexure P-5) and 30.09.2015 (Annexure P-6) respectively, in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and copy of the order so passed shall be communicated forthwith to the petitioners.
