The petitioner, who is working as Assistant Sub Inspector in Haryana Police, has sought a direction to the respondents to depute him for the Upper School Course.

It is the case of the petitioner that his juniors have been deputed for the Upper School Course ahead of him.

Learned State counsel submits that during the pendency of this writ petition, the petitioner was deputed for the Upper School Course, which he has successfully completed. He further states that the case of the petitioner will be considered for seniority viz-a-viz his juniors in terms of his eligibility and in accordance with law.

In view of the above, this petition would not require any adjudication on merits. However, the respondents shall consider the case of the petitioner for seniority ahead of his juniors as per his eligibility and in accordance with law

within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
