Reply has been filed by respondents No.1 to 4, wherein, it has been mentioned in para No.4 of the reply on merits that pay bill for the period from 01.03.2011 to 21.03.2011 and arrears of 43 months has been sent to treasury. However, due to some objections raised by the treasury, the same has been sent to the competent authority. It is also mentioned that as soon as the approval is granted, the pay of said period and arrears would be released to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued to take decision upon the matter within some stipulated period.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and also the stand of the respondents No.1 to 4 in para No.4, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to release the amount as per entitlement within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
