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MAHESH GROVER.J.

The grievance of the petitioner is that the qualification of M.Sc. Bio-Informatics should find mention in the recruitment rules as this has deprived her and possibly other people who are similarly possessed of this qualification from employment even though it is of a specialised nature and well suited for the assignment for which she participated once successfully but failed ultimately in view of the fact that this qualification did not find mention in the recruitment rules leading to cancellation of her appointment.

We have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and notice our visible constraints in mandating the rules making authority to frame recruitment rules in a particular way. However, since the petitioner herself has made an application to highlight the grievance in this regard before the competent authority, we would deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition without making comment on the merits of the controversy but with a clear direction that the respondent No.2 may look into the representation to take a decision thereon as expeditiously as possible but not later than two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Petition disposed of.
