The appeal is for enhancement of claim for compensation for injury sustained in motor accident. He was a boy aged 17 and the accident required treatment and two surgical interventions that detained him in the hospital for a month. The mother who was working is reported to have dropped her job to attend to the boy. The court provided for the medical expenses incurred to the tune of Rs. 1,67,128/- and added Rs. 40,000/- for special diet, pain and suffering. The grievance is that the Court has not taken care of the attendant charges and transportation. The patient had been taken from Yamuna Nagar to Chandigarh and then from Chandigarh to Karnal. I will make provision of Rs. 5,000/- towards transport expenses and provide further sum of Rs. 5,000/- towards attendant charges. If the boy has not lost the year and denied his studies, I do not find that there is any scope for increase due to loss of amenities.

This will mean that the petitioner will be entitled to additional sum of Rs. 10,000/- with interest @ 9% from the date of petition till the date of payment. The liability shall be on the insurer.

The award is modified and the appeal is allowed to the above extent.
