The claimants are in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation in regard to death of Kartik, aged about 17 years in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 24.10.2012.

The claim petition was filed by parents of the deceased by invoking the provisions of Section 163-A of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (in short, the Act).

Perusal of the award passed by the Tribunal particularly the findings qua assessment of compensation do not indicate that the Tribunal has faulted in any manner while assessing compensation in consonance with the structured formula provided for in the Second Scheduled appended to Section 163-A of the Act. Counsel for the appellant is not in a position to say something in order to justify intervention in assessment made by the Tribunal.

For the foregoing reasons, the appeal fails and is accordingly dismissed.
