The respondents allotted a tenement to the petitioner as well as one Smt. Anjali jointly. The petitioner claims to be entitled to the same in his name alone. He states that the said Smt. Anjali if at all is entitled to a separate allotment. He further states that he is neither related to her, nor ever occupied the premises jointly with her. The respondents, however, by a letter of allotment dated 16.05.2001 allotted a constructed site upto plinth level bearing No. 3686, Sector 25, Chandigarh to them jointly. A representation dated 24.11.2015 (Annexure P-5) in that regard is pending with the respondents. However, for some reason, nothing was done for fourteen years.

2. The petition is, therefore, disposed of by directing the respondents to decide the petitioner's application in its turn. The authorities, however, must consider the petitioner's application only after affording the said Smt. Anjali also an opportunity of being heard as there may be a possibility of conflicting interests.
