1.) While we do not find any ground to interfere with the alleged action of the Gram Panchayat in filling up the pond where the petitioners and other villagers are claiming to be discharging the dirty water or sludge, the issue of alleged non-approval of the Competent Authority, if any, may be examined by the authorities to whom the petitioners have represented vide representations dated 17.12.2015 (P-9 and P-10).

2.) The writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of with a direction to the authorities concerned to decide these representations, in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
