- 1.) Notice of motion.
- 2.) On our asking, Ms. Kirti Singh, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Let three copies of the writ petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day failing which this order shall be automatically recalled and the writ petition shall stand dismissed for non-prosecution.
- 3.) Since no order prejudicial to the interest of respondents is being passed, no reply is required at this stage.
- 4.) The petitioner is a resident of Village Basai, Tehsil Nuh, District Mewat. He seeks a direction for shifting the Polling Booth No.40-43 of Gram Panchayat of his Village Basai from Government

Senior Secondary School, Basai to Government Middle School, Basai. It is claimed that the above mentioned polling booths were decided to be set up at Government Middle School but by mistake, the venue of booths has been shown as Government Senior Secondary School, Basai. Reliance is placed on a communication sent by BDPO, Nuh to SDO (Civil), Nuh on 6.1.2016 (P-4).

5.) Having heard learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the fact that the election is scheduled to be held on 24.1.2016, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner, Mewat and SDO (Civil), Nuh to verify the above stated claim of the petitioner and if there is no administrative difficulty, let the correction in relation to setting up of above mentioned polling booths of Village Basai be considered. However, if due to some administrative reasons it is not feasible to shift the polling booth, in that event, it is directed that appropriate arrangements for peaceful, fair and transparent polling at the above mentioned polling booths be made.

6.) A copy of this order be given to Ms. Kirti Singh, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana for information and necessary compliance.
