The petitioner seeks the counting of his previous service with MES for the purposes of pension.

Admittedly, the petitioner retired in the year 1996. For a period of almost 20 years, he has chosen not to agitate for his rights. In such circumstances, this Court does not feel that it is a fit case to exercise its extraordinary writ jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

Writ petition is, accordingly, dismissed. However, it will always be open to the petitioner to agitate for his rights before the alternative forums, available to him, in accordance with law, as it is the case of the counsel that it is a recurring case of action.
