Surya Kant, J. (Oral):

Petitioner is resident of House No.15, Islam Nagar (Reda Basti), Ganaur, District Sonapat. He relies upon the voter card (Annexure P-1) issued by the Election Commission of India on 10.3.2007 as well as Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) to prove that he is a bona fide resident of the above stated place which falls in Ward No.9. The petitioner further relies upon the Ganaur Assembly Constituency voters list (Annexure P-4) wherein also his name as well as that of his wife (Sheela) are included in the voters list. However, the petitioner and his wife's names have suddenly disappeared from the voters list which has been revised for the purpose of ensuing municipal elections. The petitioner claims that he is a prospective candidate to contest the election of Municipal Councillor from Ward No.10 but his name as well as that of his wife has been got deleted at the last

moment without any notice with a view to deprive him from contesting the election.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

Ms. Kirti Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on their behalf.

The Deputy Commissioner, Sonapat and SDO (Civil), Ganaur are directed to verify the above stated documents, relied upon by the petitioner, and if everything is found in order, restore/include the petitioner's as well as his wife's names in the revised voters list. The needful shall be done within one day and in case the petitioner's claim is accepted, the authorities shall be required to re-schedule the election programme though they shall be at liberty to hold the election on the date fixed.

A copy of this order duly attested under the signatures of the Bench Secretary be supplied to learned Counsel for the parties.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
