Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have already represented to the authorities vide representation dated 11.04.2016 (Annexure P-23) and even given a reminder dated 06.05.2016 (Annexure P-24). He further submits that the matter is no more *res integra* and has already been decided by this Court in **CWP No. 19007 of 2002** on 20.05.2011 (Annexure P-9), whereby number of writ petitions have been decided and even the LPA and SLP filed against the said order have been dismissed vide order dated 12.08.2013 (Annexure P-10) and 05.09.2014 (Annexure P-11), respectively. In view of this, counsel submits that State should atleast take decision on his representation.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners, after perusing the paper-book and keeping in view the facts and circumstances, however, without commenting on merits of the

case, instant petition is disposed of, without issuing notice to the respondents, with a direction to respondent No.3-Director of Industries and Commerce, Punjab Corporation, Ludhiana, to take a decision on the reminder dated 06.05.2016 (Annexure P-24), in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and copy of the order so passed shall be communicated forthwith to the petitioners.
