Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 to 6 to provide police protection to the petitioner from respondent No.7 to 12 or other persons who are threatening to kill the petitioner.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of, without issuing notice to the respondents, with a direction to respondent No.4-S.S.P. Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur to redress the grievance of the petitioner, as

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mentioned in application dated 10.05.2016 (Annexure P-1), in accordance with law. If it is found that there is a threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioner, adequate steps be taken.
