The petitioner seeks consideration of his case for correction of date of birth as “17.02.1999” from “10.02.2000”. Further correction is sought in the name of the petitioner as “Pardeep” in stead of “Pareep” and in the mother's name as “Usha Rani” instead of “Usha Devi” in the secondary examination certificate dated 17.12.2015 (Annexure P/2) issued by the respondent-Board.

The said claim is based upon the birth certificate (Annexure P/1) which was registered on 26.9.1999 and issued by the Registrar, Births and Deaths.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that necessary representation has also been filed on 18.3.2016 (Annexure P/3) with the respondent-Board but of no avail. Resultantly, the present writ petition has been filed.

Notice was issued to the Board which has been duly received by it. However, none has put in appearance on behalf of the Board.

Keeping in view the fact that the representation (Annexure P/3) is pending consideration and decision on it is still to be taken, the

Court is of the opinion that it is appropriate if the respondent-Board is directed to take action on the above said representation and decide the claim of the petitioner as per its Regulations within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.

In case any adverse order is to be passed then a reasoned order be passed by the respondent-Board and be conveyed to the petitioner.

The present writ petition is disposed off with the aforesaid directions.
