The petitioners have challenged order dated 16.06.2015 passed in appeal by the Appellate Authority in which it has been held that respondent No.1 has not tampered with the meter nor the petitioners has produced any evidence which could have proved otherwise, therefore, while allowing the appeal, it was ordered that the amount already deposited by respondent No.1 shall be adjusted in the successive bills.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that the order under challenge is non-speaking and has tried to raise various issues before this Court but when she was asked as to whether she had raised those issues before the Appellate Authority, she could not give any satisfactory answer as no averment has been made in the petition that

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the petitioners had raised a particular issue before the Appellate Authority which has not been decided by it deliberately.

Consequently, I do not find any merit in the present petition and hence, the same is hereby dismissed.
