Mr. Manuja has produced a sealed cover containing 18 papers, which have been stapled as per directions issued earlier to know the reason for repatriation of the petitioner to his parent department. They are either in A-4 or A-6 size.

Their photocopies are taken on record with a direction to the Court Secretary to put them in a sealed cover and place it in the file of the case and the original bunch is returned to Mr. Manuja for safe custody in the department.

Having regard to the contents of the information shared by the Police Department, Punjab with the Court, I do not find any reason to interfere in this matter and would dismiss the petition.

It is directed that the sealed cover taken on record be not opened except by orders of the Bench in case of appeal.
