The petitioner is seeking directions to the respondents to depute him in the Lower School Course (List B-1) under 35% quota. As per the amendment in the Punjab Police Rules, 35% quota meant for seniority-cum-merit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to a judgment of Division Bench of this Court passed in **CWP No.7952 of 2004** titled **Naresh Kumar Vs. State of Haryana**, decided on **05.11.2004** whereby while interpreting the above said rules it has been held that for deputing to the lower school course, minimum requisite merit/fitness is required, the senior has to be placed on list B-1 as a matter of preference.

In this regard, the petitioner has given a legal notice dated 13.11.2015 (Annexure P-7) to the official respondent(s) but no decision has been taken thereon.

In view of above, without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondents, to look into the legal notice dated 13.11.2015 (Annexure P-7), within a period of three months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
