The present appeal has been directed against order dated 01.12.2015 passed by the Additional District Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib whereby the order passed by the executing Court has been set aside and the matter has been remitted to the executing Court for deciding the objections after framing of proper issues and providing opportunity to the parties to adduce evidence.

Counsel for the appellant would submit that dispute in regard to the suit property has been set at rest in litigation that remained pending for about 35 years. He has given up challenge to the impugned order but with a prayer that the executing Court may be directed to dispose of the matter within a stipulated time frame.

In view of the limited prayer made by counsel for the

appellant, the appeal stands disposed of with a direction to the executing Court to decide the objection petitions, in compliance with the order passed by the Additional District Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib, within a period of eight months. The executing Court may also examine if there is any possibility of compromise between the parties and in that eventuality, the parties may be referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre at Muktsar Sahib, if any.
