K.Kannan, J. (Oral)

1. The Insurance Company has been made liable. Notice to respondents 1 and 2 is dispensed with.

2. The ground for appeal is that the conventional heads of claims for loss of love and affection for parents has not been adequately given. The funeral expenses were also given at a modest amount of only ₹5,000/-. I will make possible an amount of ₹50,000/- as the loss of love and affection to a parent and an additional amount of ₹20,000/- as going towards funeral expenses.

This would mean an additional amount of ₹65,000/- which will attract interest at 7.5% from the date of petition till date of payment.

The liability shall be on the Insurance Company.

3. The award stands modified and the appeal is allowed to the above extent.
