This application has been filed by the appellant for condonation of delay of 132 days in filing the present appeal.

The respondent No.3-Insurance Company has filed the reply contesting the said application.

I have heard Mr. Ashok Kumar Sharma, Advocate, learned counsel for the applicants-appellants and Ms. Vandana Malhotra, Advocate, learned counsel for respondent No.3 - Insurance Company.

It is settled principle of law that the approach to condone the delay should be liberal and valuable rights of the parties should not be declined simply on technicalities.

Thus, in view of the reasons mentioned in the application, I found that there is sufficient cause for condonation of delay in filing the present appeal. Thus, the application is hereby allowed and the delay of 132 days in filing the present appeal is hereby condoned.
