Learned senior counsel appearing for the appellant-husband referring to the memorandum of understanding, which has been placed on file, submits that both the parties have amicably settled their matrimonial discord and executed a memorandum of understanding, pursuant to which having invoked the provisions of Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act'), they have jointly filed a petition before the Competent Court for dissolution of their marriage by mutual consent.

In view of the above development in this case, the petition stands dismissed as infructuous with liberty to the parties concerned to seek review of this order in case the proceedings under Section 13-B of the Act, which they have filed jointly, do not fructify.
