

Suresh Kumar Vs. Rakesh Kumar and ors.

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Vide order dated 22.03.2016, on behalf of the appellant, proposal was made to enhance compensation by ₹14,00,000/- over and above the amount awarded by the MACT in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal and the matter was adjourned for concurrence of the respondent - Insurance Company.

Today, learned counsel for respondent No.3 – Insurance Company states that Company is agreeable to pay only an amount of ₹11,00,000/- and not ₹14,00,000/- over and above the amount awarded by the MACT. This counteroffer of ₹11,00,000/- has been accepted by learned counsel for the appellant, who has signed the statement.

Thus, as agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant and learned counsel for the respondent - Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹11,00,000/- (₹ Eleven Lac Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed – cheque for ₹11,00,000/- in the name of the appellant – Suresh Kumar son of Chiranji Lal with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 27.10.2016, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this

amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of

the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
