This is an application for setting aside the impugned order dated 12.05.2015 and for releasing the FDR with Haryana Bank Narnaul.

With the consent of both parties, the appeal itself is disposed of and the application is dismissed as unnecessary.

FAO No.556 of 2014

It was a case of death of a 40 years of old person who was serving in Indian Army, drawing a salary of ₹23,826/-. There was a sure prospect of increase in income and the court applied 50%

increase, made a 1/4th deduction and applied a multiplier of 15 to assess the compensation. The decision follows to a T all legal principles involved for assessment and there is simply no merit in the appeal at all. The court has also given directions about the extent of amounts that will be permitted to be withdrawn and the direction contained in para 24 of the Tribunal's judgment will govern the rights of parties. The appeal by the Insurance Company is dismissed.
