1. Both the counsel for the claimant and the counsel for the respondent agreed that there could be award of an additional amount of ₹1 lakh in full quit of all claims against the insurer. The amount shall be paid within a period of 2 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, failing which, the award will also attract interest additionally at 7.5% from today.

2. The award stands modified and the appeal is allowed to the above extent.

3. The above case was brought up along with yet another case in FAO No.6258 of 2013. Directions have been given from

time to time about the manner of disposal of motor accident claims.

The settlement has been arrived at in the above case but the disposal may not require the file to be consigned. Instead the same may be tagged along with FAO No.6258 of 2013 so that the benefit of directions given in the above cases can be continued till it is finalized.
