Pursuant to the order dated 27.07.2016 the Insurance Company had brought three crossed-cheques of ICICI Bank dated 06.08.2016; 1) bearing No. 467847 in the sum of ₹ 7,00,000/- in the name of appellant No.4-Surinder Kaur; 2) bearing No. 467849 in the sum of ₹ 19,90,000/- in the name of appellant No.1-Harpreet Kaur and yet another 3) bearing No. 467848 in the sum of ₹ 28,00,000/- in the name of appellant No.1-Harpreet Kaur. Further as per previous order appellant No.1-Harpreet Kaur would get made two FDRs in the sum of ₹ 14,00,000/- each in the name of minor appellants No. 2 and 3 i.e. Gurkirat Singh and Jaideep Singh to be renewed every year till they attain the age of majority. The FDRs cannot be got encashed by the mother pre-maturely. For that purpose she will have to obtain orders from the Hon'ble High Court, if circumstances so exist. The cheques in the sum of ₹ 7,00,000/- & ₹ 19,90,000/- had been handed over to Mr. Narinder Kumar Vadehra, Advocate, counsel for the appellants by learned counsel for the Insurance Company on 10.8.2016 (copy placed on record) and the cheque of ₹ 28,00,000/- has been handed over to appellant No.1-Harpreet Kaur today for converting the amount into two FDRs for ₹ 14,00,000/- each in favour of her minor sons, appellants No. 2 and 3 i.e. Gurkirat Singh and Jaideep Singh, as observed above.

Appeal stands disposed of accordingly.
