Even on second call, none has appeared. In the order dated 03.08.2016, it was noticed that none appeared on that date also. There is a delay of 2060 days in filing the appeal. An amount of Rs.25,000/- required under Section 173 of Motor Vehicles Act has not been deposited, nor the order dated 31.03.2014 has been assailed vide which application for setting aside exparte order was declined.

Learned counsel for the appellant was required to explain the aforesaid anomaly. Today, despite pass over, none has come forward to answer the query as pointed out in order dated 03.08.2016. It appears that the appellant is not interested in pursuing this appeal anymore.

Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed for non-prosecution.
