The claimants are in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation awarded by the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Sonapat (in short 'the Tribunal') in regard to death of Dalbir in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 04.12.2014.

Counsel for the appellants has submitted that the Tribunal has awarded an amount of Rs.1 lakh to the parents for loss of love and affection, which is lower side. The interest awarded at the rate of 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till realization also needs enhancement.

I have gone through the paper-book particularly the award but find no justifiable reason to interfere either in assessment of compensation or award of interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till realization.

No other point has been raised.

Dismissed *in limine*.
