The appellant-husband as well as respondent-wife are present along with their respective counsel. They swore to respective affidavits and submitted that their affidavits be treated as statement during second motion.

The appellant as well as the respondent filed petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act before this Court on 03.09.2015. They swore to individual affidavits during first motion. When the matter came up today for recording their statements during second motion, they swore to individual affidavits without any pressure or undue influence to the effect that they have agreed to dissolve the

marriage between them amicably by seeking a decree of divorce by mutual consent, filed affidavits and statements without any pressure and undue influence.

As the appellant and the respondent have amicably settled their dispute and agreed to obtain the divorce by mutual consent without any pressure and undue influence from any quarters, we are pleased to grant divorce by mutual consent.

Therefore, the petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act is allowed. A decree of divorce by mutual consent is hereby passed, thereby dissolving the marriage between the parties. Decree-sheet be drawn accordingly.
