We went through the report submitted by the Mediation and Conciliation Centre. We also perused the settlement/agreement entered into between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre. It is found that both the parties have amicably settled the matrimonial dispute subsisting between them.

In view thereof, counsel appearing on either side submitted before us that the parties have proposed to move a necessary application to convert the petition originally filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, which gave rise to FAO No.28 of 2016, into one under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act seeking divorce by mutual consent.

In view of the above development in this case, as prayed for by counsel for the appellant, the appeal stands dismissed as withdrawn.
