K.Kannan, J. (Oral)

1. The appeal is at the instance of parents seeking for enhancement of compensation for death of a boy aged 15 years. A notional income of ₹4,000/- was provided and after making 50% deduction, the Tribunal assessed the loss of dependency and added ₹1 lakh towards love and affection and ₹25,000/- toward funeral expenses and ₹10,000/- for head of transportation.

2. The objection is that there must have been a provision for increase in future prospect. Future prospect of increase is possible in cases where a person was already earning. If the

deceased was minor and the court was providing for a projected income at ₹4,000/-, there is no scope for making a provision for increase on notional income. All the heads of claims have been properly addressed and there is no scope for further increase. The appeal is dismissed.
