This order be read in this case as well as in F.A.O. No. 6897 of 2015.

In F.A.O. No. 6570 of 2015, MACT awarded a total sum of ₹ 2,75,000/- as compensation to respondent Nos.1& 2 i.e. Smt. Manjit Kaur and Sh. Chet Singh whereas in F.A.O. No. 6897 of 2015 Manjit Kaur-Respondent No.1 has been awarded a total sum of ₹ 70,000/- by the MACT. Since the vehicle was not insured, the liability to pay the compensation was fastened on Ranbir Singh, driver of the alleged offending vehicle (appellant) and the owner Sh. Sanjay Gajamber, respondent No.3. Ranbir Singh filed appeals against the aforesaid MACT awards bearing F.A.O. No. 6570 of 2015 & F.A.O. No. 6897 of 2015. On the last date of hearing respondents No. 1 & 2 in F.A.O. No. 6570 of 2015 and Manjit Kaur-Respondent No.1 in F.A.O. No. 6897 of 2015 had settled the dispute with appellant-Ranbir Singh that if he pays a total sum of Rupees three Lacs in both the cases, the cases would stand settled and nothing more will be due from appellant-Ranbir Singh or any other person.

Today, Respondents No. 1 & 2 in F.A.O. No. 6570 of 2015 and

Manjit Kaur-Respondent No.1 in F.A.O. No. 6897 of 2015 have made a joint

statement that they have received Rupees Three Lacs from appellant-Ranbir Singh and any appeals filed by Respondents No. 1 & 2 in F.A.O. No. 6570 of 2015 and Manjit Kaur-Respondent No.1 in F.A.O. No. 6897 of 2015 for enhancement of compensation would be got withdrawn in view of the settlement between the parties.

As per the statement of the parties, the appeals are accordingly dismissed as having been rendered infructuous as the matters have been settled between the parties. Respondents No. 1 & 2 in F.A.O. No. 6570 of 2015 and Manjit Kaur-Respondent No.1 in F.A.O. No. 6897 of 2015 will withdraw the execution applications for executing the MACT awards pending in the Court at Panchkula.

The amount deposited by appellant-Ranbir Singh while filing the aforesaid appeals i.e. ₹ 25,000/- each; total ₹ 50,000/- is ordered to be released to him by the office of Hon'ble High Court.

The appeals stand disposed of accordingly.
