AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in C.M. No.8770 CII of 2016 is for disposal of the appeal in the light of compromise dated 19.04.2016 (Annexure A-1), which has been entered into between the parties, according to which both of them have decided to stay together and, therefore, restitute their conjugal rights with their own sweet will and for the sake of future of the child. Applicant-appellant, Rekha, alongwith her minor male child has started living in the company of her husband, Sachin. Counsel for the applicant-appellant, therefore, asserts that the appeal may be disposed of in the light of said compromise.

Respondent Sachin son of Tarif Singh and appellant Rekha

wife of Sachin daughter of Sh.Chand Ram are present in Court. They accept the compromise dated 19.04.2016 (Annexure A-1) entered into between them. Respondent Sachin states that he has no objection if the present appeal is allowed and exparte decree dated 16.03.2010 passed by Additional District Judge (Fast Track), Jhajjar, is set-aside. Similarly, applicant-appellant Rekha states that the present appeal may be disposed of in the light of the compromise dated 19.04.2016 (Annexure A-1). They have also filed their respective affidavits in Court today, which are as per their statements made in the Court. The same are taken on record.

In view of the above, the present application is allowed. The impugned order dated 23.12.2013 passed by Additional District Judge, Jhajjar, dismissing the application for setting-aside the exparte order dated 08.03.2010 and the exparte judgement and decree dated 16.03.2010 passed by the Additional District Judge, Jhajjar in HMA Petition No.18 of 2008 titled as 'Sachin Vs. Rekha', are set-aside in the light of compromise dated 19.04.2016 (Annexure A-1). The parties will be bound by the terms and conditions of the compromise dated 19.04.2016 (Annexure A-1).

The appeal stand disposed of in the above terms.
