Vide order dated 14.1.2016 on the basis of statement made by learned counsel for the appellants a proposal was made for enhancing compensation by ₹11,00,000/- over and above the amount already granted by the MACT concerned. Today, learned counsel for the Insurance Company has stated that the Insurance Company has agreed to enhance the compensation only by ₹9,00,000/- and not by ₹11,00,000/- and has signed to that effect. Learned counsel for the appellants has agreed to this counter-offer of the respondent-Insurance Company.

Accordingly, ₹9,00,000/- (Rs. Nine Lac only) is allowed as further compensation over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT.

The enhanced amount would be paid as follows:

Appellant No.1-Baljit Kaur - ₹4,00,000/-; Appellant Nos. 2 & 3-
Gurmankjit Singh and Gursangat Singh (minors) - ₹2,00,000/- each;
Appellant No.4-Swaran Kaur - ₹1,00,000/-.

Two months' time is allowed to the Insurance Company to deposit the said amount before the MACT, Amritsar from today who

shall distribute the amount to the appellants as per the shares indicated above and the share of the minors be deposited in fixed deposit in some nationalized bank till they attain majority, failing which interest at the rate of 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order.

The appeal is disposed of accordingly.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
