Aggrieved by the dismissal of the petition filed by the appellants praying for custody of the minor child Mannat, the appellants have preferred the present appeal.

Learned counsel appearing on either side, on instructions, submits before the Court that the parties will not have any objection for disposing of the main appeal itself granting visitation right over the child to the appellants between 10.00 am and 5.00 p.m. on every second Sunday of the month on bringing the child by the respondent to the premises of the Mansa Devi Temple at Panchkula.

In view of the above consensus arrived at between the parties, we direct the respondent to bring the minor child to the premises of Mansa Devi Temple, Panchkula on every second Sunday of the month at 10.00 a.m and leave the child in the custody of the

appellants to exercise their visitation rights. They are at liberty to take the child to the near-by places. The child shall be brought back by the appellants and entrusted to the respondent on the same day at 5.00 p.m. With the above directions on the basis of the consensus expressed by both the parties, the appeal stands disposed of.
