The matter was compromised between the parties, it was reported. Therefore, this application has become infructuous. On the basis of the joint request made by the counsel appearing on either side to take up the main appeal and dispose the same, the main appeal itself was taken up today for final disposal.

Ordered accordingly.

FAO-M No.102 of 2014

Both the parties along with their respective counsel are present today. Compromise deed was also produced and the

same was taken on record. In terms of the compromise, a sum of Rs.10 lacs in the shape of bank draft towards permanent alimony, maintenance etc. was handed over by the respondent to the appellant and the same was received by her. In terms of the compromise, respondent has expressed her desire to withdraw the main appeal itself.

The counsel appearing on either side submitted that in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties, the serious allegations made by the respective parties in the original petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') and the observations relating thereto made by the trial Court be expunged.

In view of above submission, the rival allegations made by the parties in the petition under Section 13 of the Act and the consequent observation made by the trial Court with reference thereto stand expunged.

Consequently, the appeal is dismissed as withdrawn and consequently the decree for divorce granted by the trial Court is maintained. Parties are at liberty to live their life in their own terms.
