The parties have settled their dispute in the terms recorded in order dated 14.01.2016 which read as follows:-

1. 'Deepak Kumar Pabbi shall pay Rs. 4 lacs to Seema Devi as full and final settlement of her claims (past, present and future) relating to maintenance and or any claim relating to permanent alimony.
2. Seema Devi shall withdraw all criminal complaints filed by her in the Courts at Phagwara.
3. Seema Devi shall withdraw the appeal and accept the decree of divorce.'

In furtherance of the settlement, Deepak Kumar Pabbi, the respondent has handed over a demand draft of Rs. 4 lacs to Smt. Seema Devi, who is present in Court, alongwith her brother and has been duly identified by her counsel.

Smt. Seema Devi states that she withdraws the appeal and has no objection if the impugned judgment and decree affirmed.

In view of the settlement and the statement made by Seema Devi,

the appeal is dismissed as withdrawn. The judgment and decree dated 12.02.2014, passed by the District Judge, Kapurthala, is affirmed but with a direction to parties that they shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement, particularly conditions no. 2 and 3, requiring Seema Devi to withdraw all criminal complaints.

In case of any difficulty, parties would be at liberty to approach this Court.
