Applicants seek condonation of delay of 1370 days in filing the appeal.

Notice of this application was issued.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, instant application is allowed, for the reasons stated therein. Delay of 1370 days in filing the appeal is condoned. However, in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others Vs. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015 (1) SCC (Civil) 242**, the applicants-appellants shall not be entitled for interest for this period of 1370 days in filing the appeal.

CM No.1676-CI of 2012

Applicants seek exemption from filing certified copy of the impugned award.

Application is allowed, as prayed for. Exemption sought is granted.

RFA No.890 of 2012

Learned counsel for the appellants submits that present appeal is squarely covered by the order dated 14.12.2015 passed by this Court in **RFA No.9390 of 2014 (Puran Vs. State of Haryana and others)**.

Correctness of the abovesaid statement made by learned counsel for the appellants could not be controverted by learned counsel for the respondent and rightly so, it being a matter of record.

In view of the abovesaid undisputed fact situation obtaining in the present case, present appeal is ordered to be disposed of, in terms of the order dated 14.12.2015 passed by this Court in **Puran's** case (supra).

Disposed of, accordingly.
