Mr. Happy Handa, the appellant, is present in Court with his counsel and states that he shall withdraw the appeal and accept the judgment and decree of divorce provided the respondent withdraws her allegation of impotency.

Counsel for the respondent states on instructions from the respondent, who is present in Court, that she does not stand by the allegation of impotency levelled by her counsel and in case such allegation has been levelled, she has no objection in withdrawing the allegation and also withdraws the allegation if levelled, by her before any authority whether the police, or before any Court or administrative authority.

We have heard counsel for the parties and in view of statements made by the parties, the appeal is dismissed as withdrawn. The impugned judgment and decree of divorce is

affirmed. The allegation of impotency levelled by the respondent or her counsel whether before the trial Court is expunged and/or before any authority whether police, administrative or otherwise, is deemed to have been withdrawn.

The decree sheet be modified accordingly.
