Jasveer Kaur W/o Tarsem Singh and D/o Swaran Singh R/o Village Chugatte Wala, P.S. Kulgarhi, Tehsil and District Ferozepur submitted before us that her affidavit dated 17.08.2016 may be read as her statement in second motion.

Likewise, Tarsem Singh S/o Banta Singh R/o Village Nathu Wali Basti, Tehsil and District Ferozepur submitted before us that his affidavit dated 17.08.2016 may be read as his statement in second motion.

Both the parties are present in Court today. They suffered individual statements in the shape of affidavits in second motion reiterating their stand in first motion. Party No.1 has undertaken to withdraw the criminal proceedings initiated by her under Sections 498-A, 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860. They have been living separately from each other for the past four years. It appears that there is no chance for them to live together as husband and wife. The averments in the joint petition filed by them under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act are found to be true.

The parties to the marriage have mutually agreed that the marriage between them may be dissolved in terms of the settlement arrived at between them.

Both the parties have reiterated their original stand in first motion.

In view thereof, a decree of divorce dissolving their marriage by mutual consent is hereby passed. Decree sheet be prepared accordingly.

The appeal stands disposed of.
