M. JEYAPPAUL, J.(ORAL)

At the oral request of learned counsel of the parties, main case is taken up today.

The appellant alongwith her counsel and the respondent's father alongwith counsel for respondent are present. A sum of ₹3 lac, in the shape of bank draft, in terms of the agreement entered into between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, was tendered by the counsel for the respondent to the appellant, who received the same. Both the parties have undertaken to abide by the terms and conditions arrived at between them before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

In view of the fact that the matter has already been compromised between the parties and the parties have also undertaken to abide by the terms and conditions of the compromise, counsel for the appellant seeks permission to withdraw the present appeal.

Permission is granted. Appeal stands dismissed as withdrawn. However, liberty is granted to the appellant to revive the appeal, if at all, the compromise entered into between the parties did not fructify.
