Heard the submissions made by learned counsel appearing for the appellant.

This is an appeal preferred by the appellant-husband aggrieved by grant of maintenance pendente lite by the trial Court invoking the provision under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act awarding a sum of Rs.2500/- to the wife and a sum of Rs.5000/- towards litigation expenses.

The interim maintenance pendente lite awarded by the

trial Court is not at all on the higher side. Litigation expenses awarded by the trial Court is also on the lower side. There is no ground for consideration of the plea set up by the appellant in the appeal. Therefore, the appeal stands dismissed.
